DRIVER EDUCATION

Driver Education classes are open to all Milwaukee residents who will be at least 16 years old as of December 26, 2010 and younger than 18 years old on the first day of class. The fee for the course is \$150. Upon successful completion, students will earn a certificate of completion, which will allow them to take a road test to obtain a probationary license. Behind the wheel lessons are scheduled after passing the permit test (\$35 fee). Driving lessons are held once per week for six weeks (two hours per lesson). Not eligible for reduced fees.
