

DEFINITIONS OF BOCCE EVENT CODES

IT IS REALLY IMPORTANT THAT YOUR ATHLETES HAVE AN UNDERSTANDING OF THE RULES OF BOCCE AND HOW THE GAME IS PLAYED. THIS TOURNAMENT SHOULD NOT BE THE FIRST TIME THAT YOUR STUDENTS ARE INVOLVED WITH BOCCE.

I - INDIVIDUAL

A coin toss will determine which player will throw out the target ball and the boxes in which the players will play in. Each player will receive six (6) balls of one color.

GAMES PLAYED

Advanced Level	2 games, 3 rounds
Novice Level	2 games, 2 rounds
Beginner Level	1 game, 2 rounds

P -PRECISION

Each player will throw nine consecutive balls. Each competitor must throw three balls at each of the three target boxes marked on the court. A competitor must indicate prior to each attempt which box they are aiming at. Indication must be made verbally or by some physical cue determined prior to the first throw.

***** Players may use a PVC Chute

GAMES PLAYED

1 GAME, 1 ROUND

T - TEAM

Each team will consist of three (3) players. When you are entering your athlete's name make sure you assign the same number to each team member and put it under the number under the heading "TEAM".

GAMES PLAYED

2 games, 3 rounds

U - UNIFIED TEAM

Each team will consist of three (3) players; two (2) Athletes with special needs and one (1) Athlete without special education needs. When you are entering your athlete's name make sure you assign the same number to each team member and put the number under the heading "TEAM".

GAMES PLAYED

2 games, 3 rounds
