



MPS Adaptive Athletics Bocce Ball Tournament

Definitions of Bocce Event Codes

It is really important that your athletes have an understanding of the rules of bocce ball and how the game is played. This tournament should not be the first time that your students are involved with bocce ball.

I (INDIVIDUAL)

A coin toss will determine which player will throw out the target ball and the boxes in which the players will play in. Each player will receive six (6) balls of one color.

Games Played: Advanced Level 2 games, 3 rounds
Novice Level 2 games, 2 rounds
Beginner Level 1 game, 2 rounds

P (PRECISION)

Each player will throw nine (9) consecutive balls. Each competitor must throw three (3) balls at each of the three (3) target boxes marked on the court. A competitor must indicate prior to each attempt which box they are aiming at. Indication must be made verbally or by some physical cue determined prior to the first throw.

Games Played: 1 game, 1 round

T (TEAM)

Each team will consist of three (3) players. When you are entering your athlete's name make sure you assign the same team number to each team member and put the number under the heading "TEAM NUMBER".

Games Played: 2 games, 3 rounds
