TO: FALL SOFTBALL - MANAGERS & SPONSORS

RE: 2010 FALL SOFTBALL INFORMATION

CONTRACT RENEWAL DEADLINE

2009 Sponsors who wish to be assured of re-entering their team in the same league as last year must file their entry contract along with the proper fee at the Adult Sports Office, either in person or by mail, no later than 5:00 PM on **Wednesday, August 4, 2010**.

LEAGUE TRANSFER REQUESTS

Teams wishing to transfer to a different league than last year may turn in a transfer request with their renewal contract. These requests will be reviewed on **Thursday, August 5, 2010** and teams will be transferred if possible. Keep in mind that if the league you wish to transfer into is full, then you will remain in the league you played in last year.

NEW TEAM ENTRY

Entries from new teams will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis at the Adult Sports Office, 5225 W. Vliet Street, Room 163 starting at 8:00 AM on **Friday, August 6, 2010**. A league will be considered closed when six teams have been entered.

A summary of the 2010 fees for the Fall Softball Leagues are as follows:

SPONSORSHIP OF TEAM

A sponsor's establishment must be located in or have a business address in the City of Milwaukee in order to be certified under the regular entry fee. Sponsors outside the City of Milwaukee must add \$50.00 to their entry fee.

A team withdrawing from the league before the season schedules have been run will be refunded one half of the entry fee. A team withdrawing from the league after the season schedules have been run will not receive a refund.

FORFEIT FEE PROCEDURE

The forfeit fee shall be \$30.00. A team that forfeits a game must pay the fee immediately after the forfeited game. If the fee is not paid before the next regularly scheduled game, the team may be dropped from the league. A team with an unpaid forfeit at the end of the season will lose its contract renewal privileges for the following season if the fee is not paid by the renewal deadline.

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PLAYER/COACH ELIGIBILITY - PLAYER FEE CHANGES (see B & C)

- A. Every player must be officially registered, having a player card on file at the Adult Sports Office before being eligible to play.
- B. **NEW FLAT RATE** - Individuals are eligible to play by filling out an individual player card and paying the **\$15.00 player fee**, which is non-refundable (elimination of the res/non-res distinction).
- C. Teams may have an unlimited number of players on their roster, however, **only up to 15 players are assessed the \$15.00 player fee. Each additional player beyond 15 is free** but must still register by having a player card on file in order to be a legal player.
- D. All participants must reside in the State of Wisconsin.
- E. **Participants must be at least 18 years** of age at the time of registration.

LEAGUE STARTING DATE

Fall Softball Leagues will start on **Wednesday, September 1, 2010.**

PLAYING RULES

The Official ASA Softball Rules will govern play with exceptions and interpretations as noted in the League Rules and Regulations provided by the Adult Sports Office.

UNIFORMS

Uniforms are suggested although not required. Metal spikes are **not allowed** for coed leagues - metal spikes are allowed for men's leagues only!

OFFICIAL BALL

The **HOME TEAM** must furnish one (1) new and one (1) playable 12-inch inseam softball with a .40/375 rating, (**Dudley 4A-240Y – Fiber-optic yellow** per ball adoption). Teams are required to purchase their game balls from Dunn's Sporting Goods.

AWARDS

The Sports Office and Dunn's Sporting Goods will provide an award voucher to the first place team in each league.
