

# 2010 Summer Community Learning Centers (CLC) and Safe Places

## Frequently Asked Questions:

### What are the dates of the 2010 CLC Summer Program?

- June 21<sup>st</sup> – July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010 6-week program
- June 21<sup>st</sup> – August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2010 7-week program
- June 21<sup>st</sup> – August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010 8-week program
- **NO program on Monday, July 5<sup>th</sup> (4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday observed)**

### What ages/grade level are served?

- CLCs: Ages served will vary slightly by site. In general, CLCs serve the ages served by the day school. Any child/youth may attend. Youth do not have to attend an MPS school in order to attend. Students from private/parochial school may attend.
- Safe Places: Grades K-5 served. Ages/grades will vary slightly by site. Students must be enrolled in the day school program to attend.

### What are the times of the program?

- Hours will vary from site to site. Contact the CLC or Safe Place directly for current program hours. You may also refer to the CLC Sites for Summer 2010 sheet for program hours.

### Will meals/snacks be served to youth in the CLC Summer Program?

- All Summer CLC sites will offer free breakfast, lunch and a snack for youth. Some sites will also serve dinner\*. Meals are open to youth from the community. Youth 18 and under can receive free meals every weekday this summer. Interested individuals should contact the site directly to determine exact meal times and/or call 2-1-1 for the nearest location. Meals are served Monday – Friday.
- General meal times:
  - Breakfast - 8:30 am
  - Lunch - 12:00 noon
  - \*Dinner – 4:00p.m or 4:30p.m.
- General CLC program hours:
  - ❖ Mondays – Thursdays \*1:00 pm – 4:30 pm
  - ❖ Fridays 9:00 am – 4:30 pm
- \*NOTE: Lunch will be served Monday-Friday starting at 12:00 noon. Programming/activities will begin immediately after lunch.
- Most elementary and K-8 CLC and Safe Place programs will run from 7:00 am – 6:00 pm. Most middle and high school CLCs will run from 11:00 am – 5:00 pm.
- Beginning June 28<sup>th</sup>, MPS Summer School begins for elementary and middle school sites from 9:00 am – 12:00 noon. Most CLC and Safe Place programs will then run from 12:00 noon until 4:30 pm or 5:00 pm. Most elementary and K-8 sites will stay open until 5:30 or 6:00 pm for extended hours for working parents. Elementary and K-8 sites will run CLC enrichment programming for youth not attending summer school from 7:30 am – 6:30 pm.

### What does the CLC Summer Program cost? Are fees charged?

- **CLCs** – CLC programs are free of charge. However, some sites may charge a nominal fee for field trips and/or early drop off/late pick up.
- **Safe Places** – Fees will vary by site and are determined by the agency partner.

### How do I register my child for the CLC Summer Program?

- Registration is done at the school/site.

### Is transportation provided?

- **NO TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED.**

## **2010 CLC Summer EXCEL Program (EXciting Camps for ENrichment and LEarning)**

### What are the dates of the CLC Summer EXCEL Program?

- June 21<sup>st</sup> – July 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010 6-week program
- June 21<sup>st</sup> – August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2010 7-week program
- June 21<sup>st</sup> – August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010 8-week program

- NO program on Monday, July 5<sup>th</sup> (4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday observed)

**What are the ages/grade levels served?**

- CLCs: Middle school youth only. (Youth who have completed 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade)

**What time does the CLC Summer EXCEL Program run?**

- Hours will vary from site to site. Contact the CLC directly for current program hours.
- Beginning June 28<sup>th</sup>, MPS Summer School begins. CLC Summer EXCEL sites will then run from 12:00 noon until 4:30 pm
- General CLC program hours:
  - ❖ Mondays – Thursdays \*1:00 – 4:30 pm
  - ❖ Fridays 9:00 am – 4:30 pm

\*Note: Lunch will be served Monday-Friday starting at 12:00 noon. Programming/activities will begin immediately after lunch.

**Will meals/snacks be served to youth in the CLC Summer Program?**

- All Summer CLC middle school sites will offer free breakfast, lunch and a snack for youth. Some sites will also serve dinner. Meals are open to community residents. Youth 18 and under can receive free meals every weekday this summer. Interested individuals should contact the site directly to determine exact meal times and/or call 2-1-1 for the nearest location. Meals are served Monday – Friday.
- General meal times:
  - Breakfast - 8:30 am
  - Lunch - 12:00 noon
  - Dinner – 4:00 pm or 4:30 pm (Where available)

**What does the CLC Summer Program cost? Are fees charged?**

- There is no charge for the CLC Summer EXCEL Program. However, some sites may charge a nominal fee for Friday field trips and/or early drop off/late pick up.

**How do I register my child for the CLC Summer Program?**

- Registration is done at the school/CLC site.

**Is transportation provided?**

- NO TRANSPORTATION PROVIDED to or from the CLC. Transportation to off-site Summer EXCEL camps and back to CLC will be provided at no charge – provided that the child is enrolled in the CLC Summer EXCEL program.
