

# Delafield, Wisconsin **LAPHAM PEAK**

## **GRADES 2-8**

**New for 2011-2012:** More than 1,000 acres of hilly terrain (created by glaciers) are within the Lapham Peak boundaries, including a portion of the Ice Age National Scenic Trail. This glaciated topography provides excellent hiking and educational opportunities, and abundant bird life and wildlife can be observed throughout the trails. There are several prairie restoration sites and a butterfly garden.

### **Program choices include:**

- Topography (highlighting glacial and other property features)
- Orienteering/compass work
- Native & non-native communities (including habitat types & plant succession)
- Common wildlife/insects
- Birds
- Prairies

Lapham Peak is one mile south of Interstate Highway 94 (Delafield Exit #285) on County Highway C.
